SCIENCE

MATHEMATICS

Group 1:

- Multiply a proper fraction by a whole number
- Multiply improper fractions and mixed numbers by a whole number
- Find unit and non-unit fractions of whole numbers exploring parts and wholes

Group 2:

- Composition of fractions greater than one
- Compare and order mixed numbers
- Addition and subtraction of fractions & mixed numbers

The Year 4, pupils should be able to recall the times tables with corresponding division facts and will take part in the Government times tables check.
