

### Science

Our first Science topic is 'Everyday materials. We will be:

- Identifying and naming everyday materials such as wood, rock, plastic, metal, paper and glass.
- Distinguishing between objects and the material they are made from.
- Describing properties of everyday materials
- Carrying out simple tests

### English

We will be using stories to enable our writing skills of narrative and description. We will be learning:

- How words combine to make sentences
- How to join words using conjunctions
- How to write expanded noun phrases
- The correct sentence structure

### Maths

This term in we are focusing on place value addition and subtraction and times tables. We will be focusing on:

- Recognising and ordering numbers
- Representing and partitioning numbers in different ways
- Addition and subtraction within 20 and up to 100
- One more, one less
- Greater than, less than and equal to a number
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.


### Mon/Fri Learning
