

Division Dilemma Answers

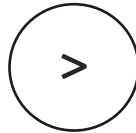
I can divide using a formal written method and interpret remainders according to the context.



Think of your own division problems to suit these comparing equations.

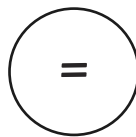
50 people can sit in a row at the theatre.

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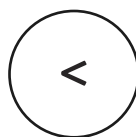


A cluster of schools are taking part in a sporting competition. How many 12-a-side teams can be made from 4275 children?
