Autumn Term 1 Information



Science

Our first Science topics are Everyday materials and Seasons. We will be:

- Describing properties of everyday materials
- Comparing and grouping materials
- Testing materials to check their properties
- Observing the changes across the four seasons

We will ask 'Why do animals live in different places?' and 'What is it like in Autumn?'

English

Our main English text will be 'The Three little pigs'

We will be writing:

- A wanted poster
- Retelling the story
- Using adjectives and noun phrases

Maths

This term in we are focusing on place value

- Recognising and ordering numbers
- Representing and partitioning numbers in different ways
- Addition and subtraction within 20 and up to 100 (Year 2)
- One more, one less
- Greater than, less than and equal to a number
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Using multiples of ten to count to 100
- Representing 3-digit numbers

Mon/Fri Learning

This term we will be focussing on History, PSHE and learning about shape in Maths.

We will be:

- Asking 'How was school different in the past?'
- Looking at how to be healthy
- Exploring properties of 2D and 3D shapes

PE

This term in PE we will be developing our wellbeing through movement
Learning new skills, working with others and getting active.

DT

This term we will be learning about stable structures

- Designing a product
- Selecting appropriate methods of joining
- Using tools effectively
- Evaluating our structures

Music

This term we will be clapping and moving to the beat, feeling rhythms and musical patterns through body percussion and use of instruments.

Our theme is 'Keeping the pulse - All about Me'

This term we will be asking the question:

- What does it mean to belong to a faith community?
