

Chargeable extras in Nursery

We accept children into our Nursery setting from 3 years old. Nursery is available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, from 9am to 3pm.

All 3 to 4 year-olds in England can get 570 free hours per year. It's usually taken as 15 hours a week for 38 weeks of the year. You can get it from the term after your child's 3rd birthday, starting on 1 January, 1 April or 1 September.

Should a child attend for more than 15 hours, they will either pay for those additional hours or some 3 to 4 year-olds are eligible for 30 hours of free childcare a week.
